- Hold a High School degree, Bachelor's degree preferred
- Hold a current Illinois Paraprofessional License by the first day of school
- Minimum of 1-2 years' experience working in a school
- CPI Training preferred

Position Qualifications and General Responsibilities:

- Provide individual assistance and support to a specific scholar (or scholars) with identified behavioral, functional, and/or academic needs according to the scholar's IEP or 504 plan.
- Provide scholar(s) on caseload with support in the classroom setting, during transitions, at enrichment, and during recess/lunch. This could include:
 - Ensuring the scholar is in the right place
 - Providing prompts and redirections to help scholar stay on task and complete work
 - Support scholar in peer to peer conversations and play
 - Restate directions and expectations
 - Accompany scholar on bathroom/water/sensory breaks



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- Collect and analyze daily behavioral and academic performance data
- Attend and participate in IEP, collaboration, and professional development meetings.
- Collaborate with general education and special education teachers in writing the scholar's annual IEP or 504 plan. Use data to drive decisions about adding or reducing SECA support.
- Execute all portions of a scholar's Behavior Intervention Plan.
- Develop and maintain frequent communication with the scholar(s) family.
- Support scholar during times of escalation- help scholars calm down, reflect on behaviors, use coping tools or strategies, etc.
- When possible, provide additional classroom supports such as: monitor independent groups/computers, check homework, prepare materials, assist with small groups
- Additional supports may be need to be provided per an individual's IEP or 504 plan. Some examples include medical support, toileting, and feeding.
